REFLECTIONS

Guruji Krishnananda

(Excerpts from old Newsletter - October 2004 issue)

There is a craze for meeting me and spending time with me. It is understandable. I allow the meetings, after saying 'no' several times. We meet, talk and spend part of the day. I go back to my chamber satisfied that I have done my part of the work, my duty, well. Satisfied partly. And sad. Sad because I could not pass on the treasure I had carried.

Generally, people come to talk about their problems and pains; to pour out. After listening to them with genuine concern and respect and after getting instructions from the Rishis, I advise, instruct and console. But when I try to indicate the Spiritual lessons from the problems they face and explain the ways to mend their ways spiritually so that the problems do not recur, they hurry up to end the meeting! They want a reprieve, not the remedy.

Sometimes, people come to talk about their experiences or just to talk about nothing in particular; to chitchat. Sometimes, they say, they come merely for my Darshan! My Darshan or presence could be motivating factors. But they themselves are not enough. People have to receive the knowledge, techniques and guidance to change, grow and progress spiritually. They have to receive, listen and open up. If they do not, the meeting is a waste of time.

People find satisfaction in simple ways – going to a temple, attending a lecture, meeting a guru etc. If the Spiritual journey ends only with this, no journey has been made at all. We have to take up Sadhana seriously; have to make serious effort to spiritualise.

People wonder if I say, "I want and wait for some people to come." I would love to spend hours with them. They have so much urge to receive, to listen to. When I pour out my Spiritual heart, I experience joy, fulfilment and relief. I see the Light from the Rishis shining in them.

Finally, I always meet people; anyone. That is my job. To meet, hear, console, guide, teach... or just listen and offer my shoulders to cry. I want the people around me to understand that the doors of this temple should be kept open always.

Little do we know that our emotions and thoughts prepare us towards our Mukti. Every emotion and every thought add to or lighten our Karmic burden. Mukti is not gained somewhere there. It is gained with every positive emotion and every thought

THUS SPOKE GURUJI

Excerpts from Guruji's talks (Compiled by Shobha K Rao)

December 2005 (Contd.)

The Rishis explained a point when I was trying to heal a person. They explained a very subtle and very fine point.

There are many laws of Karma. Some we know and many we do not know. There are many Spiritual laws. Some we know and many we do not know. In Kali Yuga, when the time itself oppresses us, the Rishis said, "Namasmaran is enough." Now we are in Satya Yuga and mere Namasmaran is not enough. Now all laws come into effect. We are bound by many laws now. We should not interfere in others' Karmas. If we think of a person, we enter into his link. Again this link is not merely having just a link. This is a positive way. We receive his energies and thoughts. We also receive sometimes some Karmas. It is such an important point that every one of us has to remember. When we think of a person, we receive so many Karmas. When we start advising, talking about him, we take so many things. When we gossip, interfere, we receive lot of Karmas of others unknowingly. Rishis will always heal and help whether we understand or do not understand. From our part it is better we try to link up after we meditate. Does it affect the person at the physical level? No – only when we link up and have very negative thoughts about him, it is then it disturbs him even at the physical level. Somehow, a person gets agitated, disturbed, because we think of him very negatively. That is why I say the best time for linking up is after Meditations!

We are entering into another year. By the time we think of sending greeting cards, the year will be closed and another year will be waiting. The Pralaya processes always get intensified. They are intensifying. Because we are protected, we are not having much of influence. We have to be careful. But at some point, from now on, you only have to deal with your problems. How long a child can be made to walk? Some day you have to depend on yourself. Each one of us has to become independent lights and have to become a Rishi. Let us train ourselves to take care of our own problems.

Let us be extra careful; let us not get scared. I am here only to caution you. Let us distance from our own egos. This is so important. The ego says, "I am a very principled person." But after ten years, we shouldn't think that our ideas were stupid ideas and we wasted our life. Let us live peacefully and allow others to live peacefully.

Accepting things in life has two aspects. The first part is - whatever God gives us - good or unpleasant - we accept. But we do not just accept and keep quiet. That is the second part - when we accept, we do not complain. It does not prevent us from making efforts to overcome the difficulties. We accept because we love God; we trust Him. He would not allow us to go through a difficult part of Life unless it is necessary. So we trust Him and we accept it. God is like a parent, He takes care of us.

Almost every person who reads the *Doorways to Light* is very much impressed; there is no doubt about it. And they always try to meet me. Most of them meet me immediately or later and I always ask out of curiosity, "What did really impress you? Which single most important factor impressed you?" People generally speak of the Astral worlds, about the Rishis, and all the fairy tale

part of it. But last week one lady told me a beautiful thing. She said, "I am amazed to know that so many people are working for our welfare and we are not aware of it. In spite of so many people working for us we are like this only, we are not changing!" Again it is true. The simple truth is that unless we decide to change, nobody else can change us; even God cannot change us; we are more powerful than God that way! We have to decide to change and then we definitely change.

I have observed that whenever we listen to a bhajan, we get elevated emotionally. The bhajan brings tears and we feel very close to God. Whenever we have a psychic experience, we feel spiritually elevated and again we feel closer to God. These are very good but these elevations are momentary. We have to rise above these emotions and experiences. These are momentary elevations. It is like sitting on a wave – a wave rises and again goes down. After these experiences, we again come down to our level. So this momentary thing, we have to make it permanent and a continuous thing. We have to be in the state of bliss; we have to be full of love all the 24 hours. We have to be in tune with the Divine all the time. This is not a new point, you know it. We have spoken about this so many times. I had just prayed to Vishwamitra Maharshi and when I was noting down this point, he came in link and said, "Emphasize this point about Yoga. People understand Yoga as union with God. We meditate and during our Meditations, we are with God, there is this union, there is this Yoga and that is partly true. We have to be in tune, in union with God all the 24 hours, and it is then the real Yoga occurs and until then it is not Yoga." I need not emphasize this and these words are from the greatest Master.

EXCERPTS FROM TALKS BY SHRI JAYANT DESHPANDE

03-03-2019

I always wonder and admire the way God has designed the Life on this earth. We always have something to look forward to. We always have a kind of hope. And we always have opportunities coming our way, to gather ourselves all over again and to make a fresh beginning. What do I mean by the beautiful design of life on this earth? I will explain what I mean. From tomorrow onwards we will have the presence of Lord Shiva on this earth for ten days. We can absorb Him, we can be aware of His presence, we can be with Him. We can meditate more. receive Him more. And after a few days we have the festival of Holi Poornima - another opportunity for us to purify ourselves and move closer to God. Then, after a few days we have the New Year, or Ugadi, when new energies flood this earth. We can make new beginnings again. Then we will have Sri Rama Navami, and in the month of May we have Buddha Poornima. Festivals keep coming and Divine Personalities keep coming, providing us opportunities, providing us the hope always. Such opportunities to celebrate Life, such opportunities to experience the presence of Divine personalities, such opportunities to absorb new energies and to make new beginnings, make the Life on this earth so beautiful. That is what I mean by the beautiful design. And of course there are many other beautiful things, which I haven't mentioned. I wonder and admire always the design of Life here.

If we feel that the world has wronged us, has been unfair to us, then how should we deal with that feeling? If, we have this feeling and if we carry such a feeling for a long time it may turn into a kind of

bitterness in us. When I say the world, I mean the people. The world is made up of people, people around us. If we feel that the world has wronged us, this feeling comes from our understanding of how people around us deal with us. How they interact with us, how they treat us? How do we deal with this feeling? How do we get over this feeling? I don't say that this feeling is wrong. There could be reasons why we have this feeling. I feel the best we can do is that we can turn to God. In a way we can say that the people, the world helps us to turn to God, to move towards God. If we turn to God, He will give us the comfort. He will provide us everything and He will help us sublimate this feeling that we may be carrying. So that's the best thing we can do, move towards God.

Other thing we can do is, we can introspect. I think that may be the best thing to do. In Spiritual Sadhana, honest introspection is so important. When we introspect we will realise that either we have been really misunderstood or we have been truly wronged. Maybe we realise that we are also wrong and the world was just reciprocating to what we were sending out to the world. It's possible. We have learnt from Guruji that what we send out comes back to us in multiples. If we send out Love, we receive Love from the Universe. With the help of introspection, we have to try to find out why do we have such a feeling? What is the root cause? And I feel an honest introspection is the best thing. When we know the truth whatever be the truth - we have to accept it. If we know that we are at fault, then we can correct ourselves and we can make sure that we do not repeat the mistakes again. We can correct or improve our attitudes, our responses to the world; improve limitations whatever or

shortcomings we may be carrying. We can meditate more, carry more Love, carry more Light.

If we realise that we are not at fault but the world has really been unfair to us, then we have to realise that probably it is a test. Otherwise why would the world unnecessarily go against us? When I say world - I am repeating - I mean the people around us. We may think that the world takes us seriously but the fact is that the world has no time for us. People have their own worries, their own issues and their own problems. They probably do not have time to think even negatively about us if not positively! So probably we are being tested.

I remember Guruji's words -"God is not a sadist." He wouldn't enjoy, if we are in pain. But, there could be tests that put us in difficult situations. It is possible. He may be testing how much of Love we carry. He may be testing how much of tolerance we have. He may be testing how much we accommodate others, how much of trust we have in Him. He may be testing our surrender. In surrender we accept everything, even negativity. When I say we even accept negativity, I mean we even accept the negative responses. I remember Guruji's words - "If God has allowed this to happen to me, it must be right. He knows what is best for me."

So, whatever be the fact, if we understand and accept the truth, then it helps us to move beyond this feeling that we may be carrying, the feeling that the world has been unfair to me. With Meditations, with Love we move into God, where no negativity, no bitterness remains. Anyway, this is what I believe. Everything in this Creation, even negativity helps our journey towards God, towards perfection.

EXTERNAL GUIDANCE

External Guidance is provided by post or e-mail for those who cannot attend the Meditation Classes. The Registration fee for guidance in English is Rs. 2500, and for guidance in Kannada, Marathi and Hindi, it is Rs. 1300. For students living outside India the Registration fee is Rs. 4500. The fee includes one year's Newsletter subscription and Textbooks.

Thereafter, the yearly Renewal fee is Rs. 2000 for guidance in English, and Rs. 900 for Kannada, Marathi and Hindi. For students living outside India the yearly Renewal fee is Rs. 3500. The fee includes one year's Newsletter subscription.

- All instructions are sent by post or e-mail (as chosen by the students) regularly.
- Initiations are made by the Rishis astrally. The progress is also monitored by them astrally.
- All questions and doubts are attended by Sri Jayant Deshpande.
- The students are expected to study the Text books thoroughly and all other publications to understand Sadhana and our Path.
- The Practice Reports have to be sent in time in the stipulated format. If the Practice Reports are not received in time, it will be presumed that the student has stopped meditating.

SPECIAL GUIDELINES BY GURUJI

- Have patience. Do not expect to experience Samadhi the first day! Do not expect miracles. But miracles do occur silently when we pursue Sadhana genuinely.
- Each one faces struggles in a different way. But struggles vanish with practice.
- Each one has experiences in a special way. But do not give too much importance to these. The experiences are good. But they are not the measures of Spiritual progress.
- Do not try to analyse the processes during Meditation. Analysis does not help Stillness.
- Thoughts are common. Do not worry.
 Do not try to drive them away. Just ignore them. There is no other way.

JOURNEY WITH THE MASTER

It was the day after Shivaratri. The day of my scheduled visit. As I entered the God's room I noticed Vibhuti all around — on Idols, pictures, walls and on ceiling too! And the smell was so heavenly!

Amara explained without any excitement.

"The Sapta Rishis visited yesterday. And they have left a mark."

"Did anyone else see them Sir?"

"Yes my wife was here. And my sister-in-law... We all worshipped them."

"Did anyone else...?"

Amara smiled as we sat down on the thick – soft carpet.

"They generally do not materialise. Once when they materialised my friend saw and talked to them. That was nearly fifty years ago."

"Is your friend alive?"

"Very much! And he is in Bangalore!"

"Can I also see the Rishis?"

"Yes... But you have to wait."

When I left Amara, I did not forget to collect the address of his friend.

I met the friend. He was bedridden. An accident had crippled him. But it could not take away the glow in his eyes. He was reluctant to talk. But when I

mentioned the name of Amara, he just melted.

"I say, you do not know him. Nobody does... Do not get fooled by his simplicity. If you put your thousand Babas together they do not equal him."

"Is he a Rishi?"

"Yes. And a very great one. Just because he wears pant and shirt do not misread him..."

"When did you meet him?"

"Nearly fifty years ago. We were school mates. He looked so different even then. First I thought he was shy. But it was not so. He was silent and... bigger than his body. He used to play, joke, tease like any of us. But... He always looked so... so big... you see..."

"Have you seen the Rishis?"

"Yes."

"Physically?"

"Yes... one morning when I went to play with him I saw the windows of his room closed. I wanted to spring a surprise. I tried the door of the window and it opened. When I peeped in to shout... I saw them sitting!... All the seven sitting in a circle along with Amara! They saw me and beckoned me to go in. I did not know then that they were the Rishis."

"The Sapta Rishis!"

"Yes, the Sapta Rishis."

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

(Compiled by Shobha K Rao)

- Q: When the Rishis heal, do they interfere with our Karmas?
- A: Rishis are very careful. They follow all the principles to the last letter. Rishis heal when we ask for the healing. They do not interfere in our lives, so they don't interfere with our Karmas.
- Q: When someone is in trouble, can I send Light and leave it at that?
- A: Send Light. The Light knows what is to be done. Light helps in every way.
- Q: Can anyone who is not in this Rishis' Path channel Light?
- A: Of course. Anyone can channel Light.
- Q: Is there anything that we can do to our departed parents?
- A: Pray to the Rishis, offer energies and send Love to the departed parents, not only on the days of death anniversaries but also on Full Moon days and New Moon days. The Rishis help us to link up to the Pitru Devatas, who carry our Love and energies offered, to the departed souls.
- Q: When a soul incarnates for the first time, can it choose to take birth in a particular Yuga?
- A: Yes it can choose.
- Q: When the souls came down for the first time and took birth, were the human bodies primitive?
- A: It is not so. The bodies were evolved enough to hold us, the souls
- Q: Do Ramayana and Mahabharata repeat in every cycle?
- A: Ramayana and Mahabharata are major events. They do recur in every cycle.

- Q: It is said that even grass will not move without the will of God. Then what happens to the Freewill?
- A: The Freewill operates all the time. We create our destinies although there is a track of destiny that we have to follow or live because of our previous lives' Karmas. We can change or alter it
- Q: Are the Ra energies liquid in nature?
- A: No.
- Q: Is a soul mate required?
- A: It's for the individual to decide.
- Q: If I have a soul mate will there be a problem in Sadhana?
- A: You alone are responsible for your Sadhana
- Q: If my soul mate is also a Meditator does it help me?
- A: Of course it helps you.
- Q: To pursue Sadhana do I have to detach from my soul mate?
- A: Soul mates have to journey together in spite of the problems and differences. You can detach from the world, from your office, but not from your soul mate.
- Q: To experience the formless God do we have to negate the forms of God?
- A: The right expression would be to 'go beyond the form', and not 'negate'. It is not easy to experience the formless. So we choose any form and go beyond the form to experience Light; then we can even go beyond the Light, as Light is also a form. This is the most important revelation. We don't know what is beyond Light. We have to go there and experience.

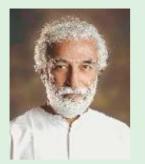

MANASA FOUNDATION (R)

established in 1988 by Guruji Krishnananda, is devoted to Light Work and conducts Meditation Training Classes in Taponagara & Bangalore city.

MANASA

is a budding settlement of Meditators near Chikkagubbi village 20 KMs away from Bangalore. Amara had a Revelation in 1935 about the activities of the Rishis and about a future City of Light here.

Cosmic Tower, Kundalini Tower and Tapovana are unique places here for Meditation.

A unique field of energy called 'Manasi' is built around Taponagara and special energies are stored here.
